

TORINO – SAN PAOLO TOWER

DESCRIPTION

The tower, whose construction will conclude in 2011, will have 39 floors and a height of 168 metres.

The tower has no air conditioning tools as it will be built according to bio-architecture principles with technological solutions able to reduce energy consumption by a third and it will be totally covered with glass and crystal.

The building will be situated in the area of the Porta Susa station; it will be constructed over an area of 7 thousand square metres. There will be a garden on the roof as on each floor. The offices will hold 3000 people and there will be an auditorium with seating for 500.
